Dear Eric,

COBSRA have informed us of the very kind offer of FRS to support a request from us to have food allocated from the "pool" of relief supplies for work-camps we hope to run in Germany this summer. I understand that FRS are also willing to allocate up to 2 dozen cases of ex-Army packs for this purpose. It is very helpful in making arrangements for these camps to have this backing from FRS.

I am sending David Sainty a copy of this letter and asking him to get in touch with you about the allocation of food and its distribution.

We have also had an offer from the International Students Service of 5 tons of various sorts of food (probably excluding ex-Army packs) which will be sent to HQ 5 with a request that it should be used on these camps of ours, if possible. They are expecting to make the shipment in June.
