### FRIEDLAND EXPENSES

I am sending copies of this letter to Douglas Childs and Marian Girling, but thought as it was a matter which also concerned future policy as regards work camps I should write to you.

It is only within the last few days, I fear, that I have been able to get down to Unit 4 accounts and in the March Accounts I found the following amounts charged to the Friedland Service

Cigarettes	<u>£ 1. 2.6</u>

Marian in her letter of the 18th April makes the following comment about this item: " The cigarettes and theatre were more or less in lieu of pocket mincy .... "

As far as I know it has not been IVSP policy to pay pocket money to short term volunteers either in this country or abroad, and unless there are special circumstances regarding the German services it would seem that we should keep on this rule. I should like to have the comments of all three of you on this.

Incidentally, Derek received a copy of a letter from Hynd to Richard Law referring to the meeting with CCG in Germany yesterday about the proposed camps, and it sounded very hopeful to me. I hope it hasn't been a case of wishful Thinking on my part!
