It was felt that the volunteers were mostly too young. They could not absorb the IVSP spirit sufficiently; and may have tended to regard the camp as just another camp. This is no fault at all of the idea of IVSP, only that not sufficient trained English and other nationality IVSP volunteers were able to be on the scheme. But all the same a great deal of valuable work has been done; and the experiment is certainly worth repeating just as soon as the balance of other nationalities volunteers car be brought up to more or less equal the German.
