11) Additional Information:

Here have arisen the inevitable slight, jealous wranglings between the Germans. A higher proportion of other nationalities would help to smooth these out. But these unforeseeable personal clashes so damaging to a young and delicate movement makes a certain amount of assistance and supervision from outside so vital, until more normal conditions prevail in Germany, and individual antagonisms resume their normal proportions again.
