French Zone:

You will be interested to hear that Douglas Sowerby visited the French authorities in Baden-Baden, with a view to seeing if we could not help with IVSP schemes there. He had been encouraged to think that our assistance was not required, by the HQ (French) in Berlin. But a different answer was given by the officials on the spot, and possibilities of assisting there next spring were opened up. But it is worthy of note that they did say that application from IVSP to be allowed in the French Zone would come better from the French Branch of S.C.I. Douglas has suggested that I send in a copy of our application (which he sent to the French authorities in Berlin) in French to Pierre Martin. Or if I can't make a copy before, I'll bring a copy of it to Brussels with me.
