GERMANY: Duisburg (Ref: SCI / 3 / 4)

- 1) Responsible Branch: British Relief teams in Germany.
- 2) Service at: (22) Duisburg, Neckarstrasse 13.
- 3) Type: Adult work camp.
- 4) Dates: January 1 - 12, 1947.
- 5) Nr. of vol: Men 14, women 4.
- 6) Leader: Not definitely selected.
- 7) Work: Preparing ground to be used as a kitchen garden for a children's hospital. Repairing tents during wet weather.
- 8) Conditions: All secretariats have been informed by Basil Eastland about special conditions for this service. Spare clothes and boots and food should be brought.
- 9) Reason for camp: To encourage new German group in working on S.C.I. lines. To give material help to the hospital. To bring constructional international spirit to Germany.
- 10) Special note: Volunteers should if possible speak German and should have good experience of S.C.I. or work with similar organisation. Selection of very good vol extremely important. No women vol required from abroad.
