Germany

The German Branch planned to have six workcamps this summer, but now they have to reduce the number to five because of the money reform. In **Neuenkirchen-Farge** a group is building a road to a hospital. This camp opened on the 3rd of July and it will continue until the 28th of August.

In **Berlin-Neukölln** volunteers are experiencing difficulties in travelling from other zones. The only way in for foreign volunteers is by air. Nevertheless, there are at present eight foreign volunteers working together with some fifteen German volunteers from Berlin. They are building a playground and the scheme will run from the 17th of July to 28th of August.

In **Freiburg i.Br.** the Service began on the 17th of July and continues until the 12th of September. The work to be done is clearing of rubbish for reconstruction of a Medical Clinic. Instead of the camps in Hamburg and Köln a long-term camp has begun again in **Mülheim**. Work is removing rubble in a worker's section of the town.

Camps of other "Askov-organisations"

The American Friends Service Committee has organized two work camps in Nürnberg and Würzburg in Bavaria. This is the first summer that AFSC has had camps in Germany. The camp at **Nürnberg**, which opened June 10th with fourteen volunteers and has now grown to twenty-five volunteers, is helping in the construction of an international peace village which will offer homeless youth a chance to live in a family and learn a trade. Twenty young Germans are working with the volunteers which come from eight countries. Nürnberg closes the middle of August. — **Würzburg** opened on July 17th and will continue until September 17th. In the beginning there were thirteen volunteers from six

countries, but the number will reach twenty. These young people are helping in the reconstruction of a building which will later be used as a youth centre.
