The IZD (IVSP) Groups have returned to their old love "stump-grubbing" in the Grunewald. With the coming of the winter and the disappearance of every second tree from the Berlin streets the necessity of obtaining wood becomes a first priority, especially for old people living alone. At Xmas time the wood will be distributed to old people. One whole week-end has been given to stump-grubbing; the group members were able to spend the night in a Jugendhaus in the American Sector and so be 'on the spot'. On the Saturday evening the young people discussed pacifism and the week-end scheme had the great advantage of helping the group to know each other.
Two excellent IVSP groups have been held at the Teams Billet. One group is busy making clothes from old material and this will be given to children in a hospital at Xmas time.
