The IC having discussed this question first by correspondence and at the present meeting, the following recommendations were made:	
i)	SCI should be ready to offer a group of volunteers in case of an emergency in this part of Europe;
ii)	The Swiss committee was asked to form a special committee which would study the problems involved if offering a group to Eastern Europe, and report the results of their discussions to the IC;
iii)	A group should only be offered, if there were volunteers available who felt a special concern for work in Eastern Europe;
iv)	The question should be raised in an article written by Henri Roser in the next issue of LE SERVICE CIVIL.
