Dear Earl,

After a good deal of discussion and correspondence I can at last say that we will definitely be working in the Donaueschingen project. Our camp will be at Geisingen.

We are going ahead with the recruiting for this camp, as you will notice in the final copy of our work camps program. Dr. Lienhart is fully informed and we are keeping in close touch with him in all our plans.

As soon as I know who the leaders of the camp will be (there will be two: one German, one-probably-American) I will let you know.

The dates which we have chosen as the best from our point of view are - 29th July to 3rd September. Any young Germans interested in this camp ought to write to Pastor Hans Hermann, Blumenstraße 2, Karlsruhe. Non-Germans should write directly to me.

I am afraid we have not been much help in choosing a deputy to work with the Landrat. Until now we have been unable to say definitely that we would have a camp there so we have not done anything about selecting such a person. Our contacts in Southern Germany are few and far between. If you have some possible leaders in mind coming from Germany I would be happy to hear about them.
