Please, let us know as quick as possible.

In addition of the service in Ratzeburg our camp in

Donaueschingen / Schwarzwald

will run until autumn 1951. There too we always need foreign volunteers for shorter or longer periods, especially for Easter-time. Conditions about working and living in the Donaueschingen-camp are well-known I think.
