Dear friends,

we have been asked if IZD / SCI feels the appeal to work in <u>Berlin</u> at this moment of tension when hatred and fear are spreading Our answer: we can see a good chance for a small international peace brigade to work in Berlin.

Until July about 80.000 persons from East-Berlin used to work in West-Berlin which is now impossible for them. Employees from West-Berlin stop working and leave Berlin to the West. The result is that all industry and other institutions are in need of workers. In some cases money can help (this help has already been started by the government) but in all the social institutions money is not the solution of the problem.

We asked two hospitals and they gladly welcomed our offer to send an international group for a period of several months. We can start the longterm-service on November 1st if we get the volunteers for at least 3 - 4 months. In the beginning there will be no payment, but free accommodation and food, perhaps pocket money which may increase after a successful time of training.

Our international workcamp at Neuenkirchen / Bremen is open until October 20th. We will pick potatoes for a hospital of the Protestant Church together with a group of German Conscientious Objectors.

October 5th - 8th in Frankfurt: We will meet and discuss SCI-work in the Middle East since 1955.

Already now we want to invite you to take part in a seminar at Neuenkirchen (28. 12. 61 - 3. 1. 62). The subject will be "Pflegedienst im Internationalen Zivildienst", with the topics: Erfahrungen in europäischen Diensten, in Langzeitdiensten, beim Ersatzdienst der Kriegsdienstverweigerer.
