Dear Frank,

Following the decision of the last ICM regarding the organisation of the East / West work camp in the GDR next year in collaboration with the Freie Deutsche Jugend, I wonder if the British branch would consider taking up the responsibility for the technical preparation of this very important camp.

This responsibility would involves :

1. The selection of SCI and other Western volunteers,
2. Possibly, the training of these volunteers in collaboration with the French branch and the ES,
3. The appointment of a co-leader (the FDJ will appoint another co-leader).

As you will remember, Michael Holman was appointed directly by the IC as SCI representative for the purpose of preparing the camp in the GDR, and if the British branch accepts the above mentioned responsibility, close contacts will be kept between the British branch, Michael and myself.

I am enclosing various documents for your information on this matter.
