Liebe Freunde !

Anbei findet Ihr die restlichen Arbeitsunterlagen für die Jahresversammlung. Ein Bericht von Hans-Ulrich Smolczyk über "Unternehmen Servia" wird zur Jahresversammlung noch fertig, das heißt, er ist schon fertig, nur habe ich im Moment keine Zeit zum Abschreiben und Abziehen.

Noch einige wichtige Mitteilungen :

Dienst in der DDR : Michael Holman schrieb, daß er zur JV nach Frankfurt kommen wird. Er schickte Kopien seines Schriftwechsels mit W. Rumpel, wovon Ihr zum Teil schon Abschriften erhalten habt.

Einige Auszüge aus seinem Schreiben vom 28. 2. an Frank Judd :

"At last I have managed to get through to the FDJ. I had received no reply to my letter of February 19th to the FDJ and so on Tuesday February 26th I sent Herr Rumpel a telegramme in the early hours of the morning telling him that I would arriving at the FDJ-Headquarters at noon on the same day !
... Rumpel was unfortunately not there, but I was able to speak to his deputies and helpers, Herr KRUGER and Fräulein ROTTIG. The meeting opened with a flood of excuses and apologies for Herr Rumpels failure to answer my letters.

The following points emerged :

- 1) The Zentralrat of the FDJ has agreed in principle on the organisation of a combined FDJ / SCI summer work camp for this year and steps have been taken to find a suitable project.
- 2) There seems to have been no decision taken on the altered wording pf the Briottet-Rumpel communiqué of September 27th 1962. However Herr Krüger went out of his way to emphasise the fact that a decision would be taken in the course of the next week, and that there is no reason to suppose that the changed wording should not meet with the approval of the responsible FDJ-committee.
- 3) Although the selection of a suitable project has been greatly hinderes by the exceptional weather conditions, a project in Potsdam seems to have turned out to be the most suitable . . .
- 4) Date : uncertain — July or August — to be agreed on a later date.
Place : Potsdam
Work : drainage of marshy, waterlogged ground.

Our 45 volunteers would not be sent as delegates to some huge project to work with hordes of other FDJ volunteers.

Before I close I would like to emphasise that all the information about the project itself must be provisional, as I have not yet seen the actual site . . ."
