I was very glad to meet our delegate in the DDR, Mr. Michael Holman, in Frankfurt last week. He informed of the arrangements made between FDJ and himself in the name of SCI concerning the East-West cam in Paaren-Glien. I have forwarded this technical proposition to the British Branch of SCI, which will be responsible for the preparation of this camp.
