Dear M. Klos,

You will remember that the International Committee of S.C.I. agreed at its meeting in November 1963 to collaborate fully in the first international Friendship camp, to be held in Hungary in 1964. At the time, you informed me that about five S.C.I. volunteers would be invited to participate in the workcamp.

We should be glad to know whether further details about the camp are available vet. We should also be glad to know who is organising the camp in Hungary, so that the French branch of S.C.I., which will be responsible for practical arrangements concerning the sending of our volunteers, can write to them

We have recently written to the organisations which have collaborated with us in the past in the USSR, Czechoslovakia, Poland, the D.D.R. and in Yugoslavia, asking them to confirm the arrangements mentioned by you and others at Marly-le-Roi.

We have also asked our branches to provide information as soon as possible concerning workcamps in July and August in which it is hoped that volunteers from the Socialist countries will participate. As agreed at Marly we will forward this information to B.I.T.E.J. for circularisation.

We have very much appreciated the valuable cooperation of B.I.T.E.J. in the arrangement of International Friendship workcamps for this year.
