Dear Herr Rümpel,

Many thanks for your letter of the 21st June, confirming arrangements for our joint workcamp at Wulferstedt. We are enclosing a list of the SCI volunteers. The passport number of Mr. Virgilio Galassi will be forwarded to you as soon as possible, and two photographs of the SCI person responsible for our group.

We are arranging for all our volunteers to meet in Paris on the 28th July, and to travel from Paris to the DDR on the 30th, arriving at Marienborn at 14.42 hours on the 31st. One or two volunteers may be unable to travel with the group, in which case they will travel separately (possibly 1 or 2 days later). I shall inform you about any such cases in more detail when the situation is clear.

Thank you very much for selecting three volunteers for our workcamp at Linz. The camp will be very similar to that in Wulferstedt as far as general conditions are concerned, except that volunteers may be required to bring sleeping-bags with them, and pocket money will be paid to volunteers from BITEJ member organisations who might experience currency-exchange difficulties. Hermann Spirik will send you full information shortly.

We very much appreciate your continued cooperation, and look forward to the practical success of our two exchange projects for 1965.
