Dear Jörg,

Regarding technical arrangements for DDR seminar :

1. volunteers must leave Hannover on the 29th in order to reach Magdeburg by train about 4.30 p. m. on that day, or on the 30th in the morning to arrive any time during the day. Can you please let me know what the train times are ?
2. I think a 2-day seminar is enough, therefore the alternatives are : -
either vols. arrive in Hannover on the 26th in the evening, and stay until about mid-day on the 29th, or volunteers arrive on the 27th in the evening, and leave on the 30th in the morning. Do you agree ?
3. What is the address of the place the seminar will be held ?
4. The leader and Michael Holman can use about 1 full day on
 - (a) the material Michael is preparing
 - (b) discussions of DDR propaganda
 - (c) discussions of points presented by the leader.Does this fit in with your arrangements ?
5. The number of volunteers recruited is 14. We hope to find another, making 15.
6. The leader is John STEWART, British.
7. I need answers fairly quickly to the above questions, to prepare the information sheet going to volunteers.
8. All the matters regarding who should speak about what at the seminar, given in your letter of the 3rd, sound interesting and the leader, Michael Holman and myself agree that you should sort out priorities according to the time available.
