**First SCI workcamp in a war destroyed village (WWI). Construction of huts for villagers. The presence of German volunteers was meant to symbolise the reconciliation between France and Germany.**

Clearing work after avalanche in a mountain village. Most workcamp participants were conscientious objectors, in order to demonstrate for alternative service.

**SCI activists on a study tour to Yugoslavia, Bulgaria and Hungary, where they met representatives of national youth volunteer organisations.**





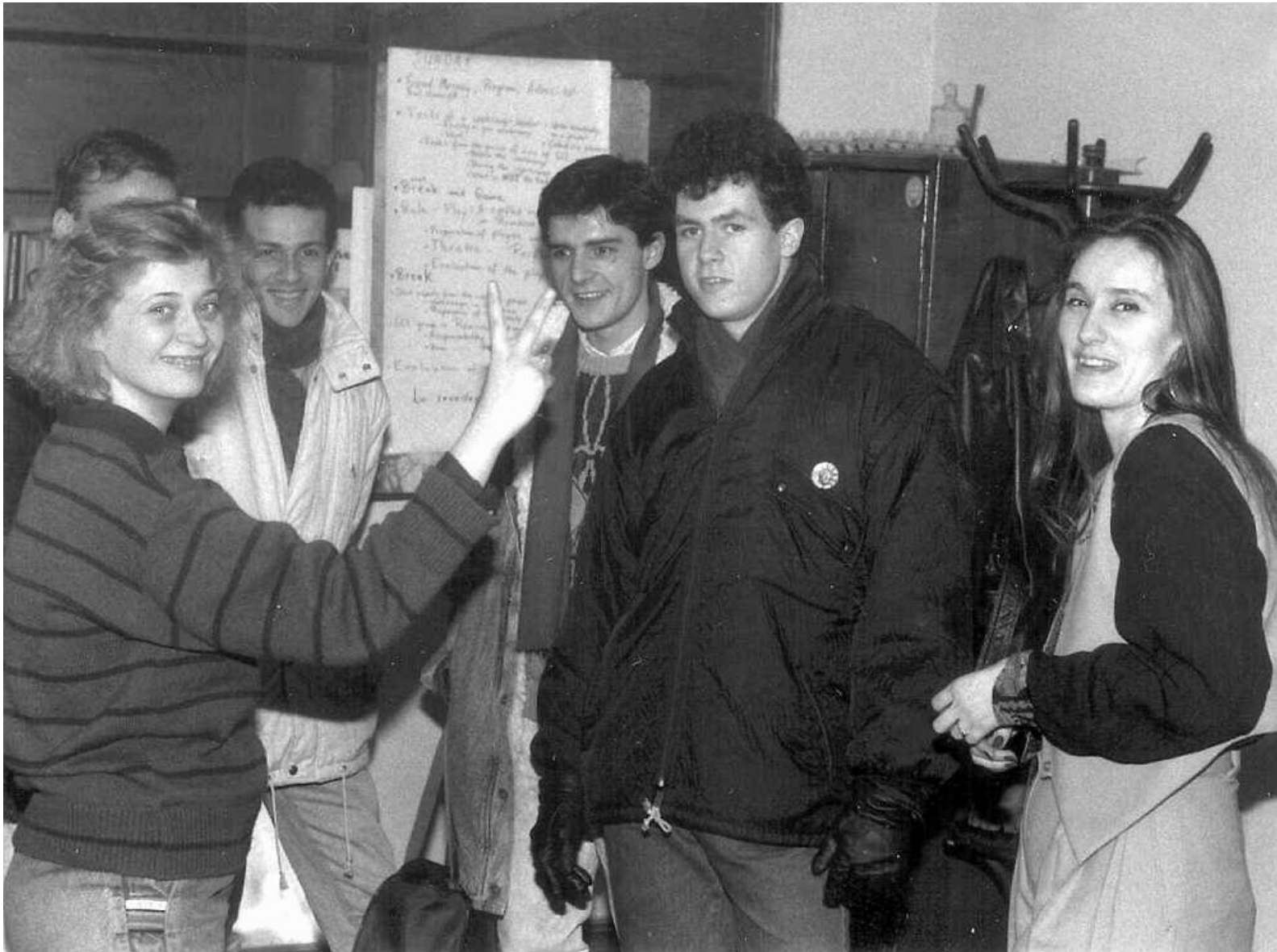
